



Temuka teenager, Phoebe Scarsbrook, impresses with passion and commitment to social justice

APPOINTED AS 'YOUTH MP FOR RANGITATA' BY ANDREW FALLOON, MP



Rangitata MP, Andrew Falloon, received seventeen applications to represent the Rangitata electorate next year in Youth Parliament.

Youth Parliament is an opportunity for young New Zealanders to learn first-hand about New Zealand's democracy and to influence decision making. The next Youth Parliament programme will occur from 1 March to 31 August 2019, including a two-day Youth Parliament event on 16 and 17 July 2019.

Andrew was impressed with the quality of the applicants, and says "we've got some incredible young people in South Canterbury doing amazing things".

From the seventeen applicants (eleven from South Canterbury and six from Mid Canterbury), Andrew interviewed four short-listed candidates (Phoebe, one from Geraldine High, one from Mountainview, and one from Timaru Girls'). He says it was a tough decision, but Phoebe's passion and commitment to social justice impressed him, as well as her debating and speaking skills, which will come in handy in the robust environment of Parliament's debating chamber.

Some excerpts from Phoebe's application, printed with her permission.

"I have always been a person that likes helping others. I have grown up in a household that likes to give more than they take. If I was the Youth Member for the Rangitata region, I would focus on giving people that don't have or don't feel confident enough to have a voice, a voice for themselves, and getting young people involved in our community and out doing things that will benefit them.

Recently I went up to Murupara, which is located 40 minutes from Rotorua. My brother is volunteering up there, and has been for the past 5 months, and my family took a trip up there to get a feel for what it was like, and what he was volunteering for. We drove into places that are unknown to a lot of people, I saw houses in Minginui with no windows and the little kids wearing shoes that had holes in them. We talked to people and made time to understand a culture that is so friendly and giving

and even though they have nothing, they are some of the most incredible, happy people I have ever met. I came back after that 4 day experience up in Murupara, feeling like I was leaving so much there. I felt like I couldn't just leave, without helping them. Then I look at my school. There are many people within my Year 11 cohort that need a voice and don't have one that is strong enough to be listened to, so I thought why not just give those people my time, and make sure they feel as though they are being listened to.

Someone I look up to a lot, even though she has passed away is Rosa Parks. She saw injustice within a situation, and she knew something needed to be done, so she stood up for her beliefs and for the black community, and stayed seated on the Montgomery Bus in 1955. It was her decision to take a stand, that created a ripple effect. She once said that, "You must never be fearful about what you are doing, when it is right," and I believe that is something we can all live by."

from our MP's desk...



Axe The Tax

The Government's new fuel taxes are placing a heavy financial burden on hard working Kiwis with high prices at the pump.

At a time of high surpluses the Government should be working to keep the cost of living down. Instead the Ardern-Peters Government is doing the opposite. Petrol prices in New Zealand are now more than 20 per cent higher than they were a year ago. They're up to \$2.44 for a litre of 91 locally.

New fuel taxes on top of record petrol prices are a major reason for that, including the recent increase on 1 October and the Auckland fuel levy which petrol companies are able to spread over the whole country.

There are two more nationwide excise taxes planned over the next two years. On top of that, Councils right around New Zealand are already asking for Auckland's regional fuel tax to be imposed on other parts of the country. Recently Winston Peters tried to defend fuel taxes by saying 100 per cent of the hundreds of millions of dollars of fuel taxes being paid by motorists goes to fund roading infrastructure and maintenance. That's simply not true.

In their first Budget the Government cut \$5 billion from state highway funding with that money funnelled into Auckland rail and cycle projects.

Over time those cuts to the state highway budget will make our roads in South Canterbury and other regions more congested and unsafe. The cost isn't limited to road users. Everything we buy, from the food in our supermarkets to the clothes we wear are transported by road. Higher fuel costs and even more taxes will push up the price of everything we buy.

We accept that quality infrastructure has a cost. But to be putting on more taxes when prices are at record highs, while running strong surpluses and cutting investment to the regions is the wrong approach.

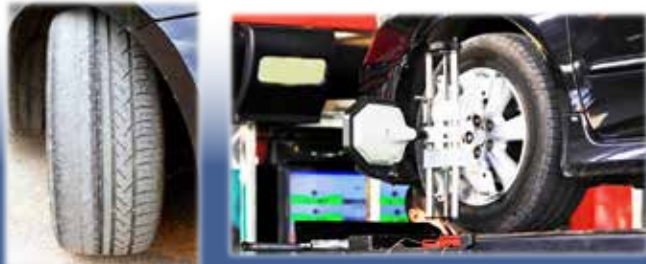

SUMMER SAFETY ADVICE BBQs and Gas Cylinders

With summer all but upon us, the following is important information on BBQ and gas bottle safety, to help you have a safe BBQ season

Many Kiwi homes have a gas-powered BBQ outside. These are great for cooking during the summer, but can also pose a fire risk if not stored and maintained correctly.

Here are some tips for reducing the risk of fire when using BBQs and gas cylinders.

THE SOAP BUBBLE TEST

A common cause of BBQ fires is gas leaking from where the BBQ hose fits into the cylinder valve.

Whenever you connect a gas cylinder to a BBQ, make sure it's hand tight. You can do this by turning the gas cylinder on, and then pouring a little soapy solution (1/4 cup of water and a squirt of liquid suds) over the valve.

If any bubbles are created you may have a gas leak. Turn the valve off and replace the cylinder O-ring.

BBQs

- BBQs are potentially dangerous when used carelessly or when consuming excessive amounts of alcohol. Treat your BBQ the same way you would a stove: don't drink and fry, and avoid leaving cooking unattended.

- Ensure you regularly check and maintain any fittings and connections. Use the soap bubble test to make sure there are no leaks.

- Leave plenty of clear space around the BBQ. Make sure there is no nearby debris that could catch fire.

- Supervise children at all times when using the BBQ.

- Remove all excess fat from the BBQ after each use.

GAS CYLINDERS

- Use the soap bubble test to make sure gas cylinders are secure and not leaking.

- Make sure the cylinder is turned off when you've finished using it.

- Have all gas appliances serviced according to manufacturer instructions.

- Store and install cylinders in an upright position

100th Armistice Day celebrations in Temuka

A parade commences at the Commerce Street carpark at 10.30am, which will proceed to the town square, where a service will be held at 11am. This will be followed by finger food and refreshments at our clubrooms. Temuka RSA - all welcome.



One hundred years ago, a significant event occurred in our history. At the eleventh hour, on the eleventh day, of the eleventh month fighting finally ceased after five long violent years of World War One.

It was not known here in Temuka until 9.30am on the following morning, by telegram from the then Prime Minister to the Temuka Post Master. The news was greeted with the sounds of the church, fire and school bells, ringing out the good news. Their sounds were heard as far away as Winchester and other outlying areas. The engines began to toot, cars sounded their horns and flags were hoisted where they waved proudly in the breeze. People cast aside their work and rushed into the streets to the Post Office, anxious to hear the news officially announced.

At 2pm a grand procession was formed, not bad in such a short time. According to the Temuka Leader, the local

newspaper, there was nearly 4000 people in the streets around Temuka. The procession started near St Peter's Church and travelled along King Street to the then High Street, now Domain Ave, to the park (now Domain), with the brass bands, returned and territorial soldiers, cadets and many more.

At 3pm an ecumenical thanksgiving service was held at St Peter's Church, on the front lawn in accordance with the stoppage of indoor meetings due to the world-wide Influenza epidemic.

Every year since people in the British Commonwealth have marked this day with two minutes silence at 11am.

So let us remember and stand proud for all the men and women who have served their countries, in the past and the present members that are serving today.

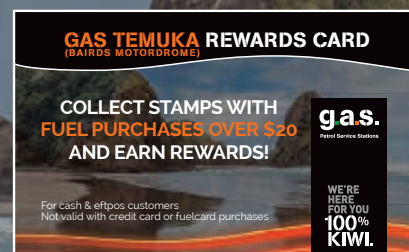

Gardening with Albert



September was another dry month with only 17.5mm of rain falling, with 22mm falling to date in October - which is very little for the two months combined, resulting in having to hose the veggie garden more often than other years. We had a cold southerly twice during September and saw snow on nearby hills. We only got one small frost that didn't do any damage.

It's not too late to sow **runner and dwarf beans, pumpkins, marrow and corn** if it hasn't already been done. I always sow pumpkin and

marrow seeds into the soil as I have found transplanting those plants never do that good, corn is okay to transplant.

Peas will need stringing up - that is having a stake at each end of the row and smaller ones between, then using twine around the end stake and then along the row to each stake, then tied to the other end stake.



Carrots will need thinning for the first time, then when they get larger you can thin them again, by which time they should be big enough to cook for dinner.



Tomatoes by now should be growing well and as they grow they produce laterals at each leaf which needs to be pinched out and done on a hot day to seal the cut.

If you are growing them in a glasshouse and using string to tie them up, wind the plant anti-clockwise around the string, if done clockwise the sun will unwind them as the sun goes east to west during the day. Don't over water while the plants are small, but water regularly when they are producing fruit, if they are left to dry out too much then water heavily they can develop blossom end rot.



Salad greens - all salad greens have one thing in common - they all need to be grown fast and lush, as you do not want to produce tough and bitter lettuces etc. Slow growing plants can be stressed by lack of water, lack of nutrients, cold days or hot days. Use fertiliser that is high in nitrogen and phosphorus for lush growth for better tasting lettuces.

Apple and pear trees should be sprayed with Mavrik to stop codlin moth getting into the fruit.

Spray your **raspberry canes** with Mavrik a week or so before they are ready to pick.

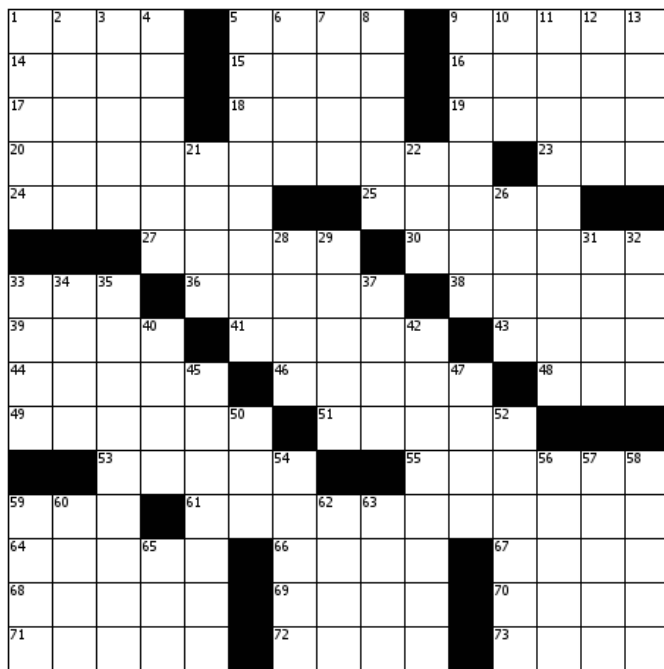
